C.T.T. Safety test and preparation, April 12-16, 2023.

Legal basis: Test - C.T.T. The safety test is carried out on the basis of COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATIONS (EU) 2019/907 of March 14, 2019 on the establishment of a common proficiency test for ski instructors based on Article 49b of Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the recognition of professional qualifications

Accession conditions: defined in Appendix II. Eligible candidates (2.1.2) COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATIONS (EU) 2019/907 of March 14, 2019 on the establishment of a common proficiency test for ski instructors based on Article 49b of Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the recognition of professional qualifications

Applications: Applications are possible until March 31, 2023 exclusively via the link

Equipment: Skis suitable for all snow conditions (preferably freeride skis, at least 90 mm in the middle) and ski poles (recommended large snowshoes), ski boots (we recommend freeride skis, 3-antenna Avalanche Woodpecker, Avalanche Shovel, Snow Probe (minimum length 240 cm), ski helmet, ski rucksack or rucksack with an avalanche airbag (if available), a set of the former aids, waterproof outerwear, warm clothes, sunglasses, ski goggles, gloves, sunscreen, notebook, pencil. Participation in the test is not allowed without complete equipment.

Introductory meeting: All accepted candidates will be informed in time about the place and time

introductory meeting.

Test structure: The security test consists of two parts and includes five compulsory modules that are assessed individually. The test consists of testing the candidate's knowledge and skills, and the theoretical and practical part of the test is conducted. If the candidate fails one or more modules or if the test does not include all modules, the candidate must repeat the test in its entirety. Content of different module is listed below.

Theory test: Urgently call the local emergency service in the language of the host country after the snow disaster. The theory test was successfully passed if the call to the emergency service was sent in a clear and comprehensible manner and contained accurate data that enabled and facilitated the provision of assistance

Practical test: The practical test for skiing outside the organized ski slopes consists of avalanche forecast analyses, group management and one of three modules that focus on meteorology, mountain hazards or snow cover analyses. Part of the practical exam is looking for that rescuing two people buried in an avalanche. A practical exam is mandatory held in one of the official languages of the member state in which conducts the exam. Three modules on group management last 15 minutes each. Each has 15 minutes for preparation. These modules the lesson is successfully completed if it is satisfactorily performed at least 75% of the tasks.
